### Report Week Beginning January 16<sup>th</sup> 2017

**Another damp start to the week with plenty of drizzle, anglers have had a good week with plenty of fish being caught. Jason Billen who fishes catch and release caught a cracking double figure rainbow weighing approximately 13lb which was safely returned, Gareth Griffiths also caught a double figure rainbow weighing approximately 12lb in weight which he decided to return, Adam Sinnott caught a double figure rainbow too weighing 12lb 7oz caught on a bloodworm and Bernard Thomas caught a double figure brown weighing approximately 10lb plus caught on a damsel which was safely returned. There is no set pattern to what flies the fish want at the moment fish have been caught on bloodworms, black and green montanas, damsels and also various colour buzzers. Papermill is now a Trout Masters Water anyone that catches a big fish will be entered into the competition for the heaviest fish of the month in the Trout Fisherman Magazine.**

- Gary Richards 4 fish 15lb 6oz caught on a black and green Montana.
- David Williams 3 fish 9lb 2oz caught on a green fritz.
- Wayne Carter 3 fish 12lb 8oz caught on a bloodworm.

## Winter Series Sunday Competition Rules

Dates January 29th February 12<sup>th</sup> 26<sup>th</sup> March 12<sup>th</sup>

2017

- The competition is to take place on the above dates
- Time 8.30 a.m. for a 9.00 a.m. start . 13.00 p.m. Finish.
- Pegs drawn at the start and then every half-hour
- Competitors can continue to fish after 13.00 on a catch and release basis
- Half hour break at 10.30 a.m.
- Cost £26 per day, equivalent to a four fish ticket plus £5 towards the prizes
- All fish to count on the day. Browns must be returned. Each brown caught will count as 2lb.
- Maximum two fish per mark. Competitors stop fishing a mark if two fish are caught and when a total of four fish are caught
- Three out of the four competition days to count for the overall prize. Lowest competition days count to be dropped
- No boobies, eggs or spinners
- One of the days to be solely buzzers, which will be provided by Mark. All competitors will receive the same.
- There will be a draw for a prize for all those who don't win a main prize and who take part in all four competitions.
