Some anglers have bagged up catching their limit of 4 and 3 fish using natural fly's such as black gnats, pheasant tail nymphs, grey dusters and march browns. Water is cooling down nicely so fishing will get better, some nice blues have been stocked 4lb plus in weight and they are great to target in the lake. Richard Bowen caught a lovely 4lb 8oz blue on a grey duster, David caught a cracking brown 7lb plus and Dougie Rees caught a beautiful looking brown weighing approximately 4lb plus on a goldhead hates ear which was safely returned back in to the lake, browns are moving a lot around the lake at the moment.
